What is the Community Support Phone Service?

This is a **FREE** service that is available to all Meals on Wheels Central Coast and One Direct Connect clients.

Available from 8am to 4pm Monday to Friday, clients are welcome to call us on 4357 8444 to chat about an array of issues that could be concerning you.



What issues can I discuss when I call?

You can talk to us about issues you may be facing such as social support, mental health, advocacy, elder abuse, and rights and responsibilities in the aged care sector. Our focus is to resolve your concern, and we will do this by referring you on to the appropriate service.

Please provide as much information as you can when you contact us so we can help understand your issues and concerns.

How does the Community Support Service work?

A trained staff member will be on hand from 8am to 4pm Monday to Friday to take your call and listen to your concerns. Call 4357 8444 to access this free service.

After listening to you and assessing your needs, we will then link you with the appropriate service that can further assist you.

How much does the Community Support Service cost to access?

The Community Support Service is free.

We will listen to your concerns and then will link you to services that offer free advice, or those that bulk bill.

How do I access the Community Support Service?

To access the Community Support Service you need to be a client of Meals on Wheels Central Coast or One Direct Connect.

If you utilise any of our services including Meals on Wheels Central Coast/NDIS/Home Care Package meals, community restaurant, or one of our assisted shopping programs, then you are able to access this service.

Will the information I discuss remain confidential?
